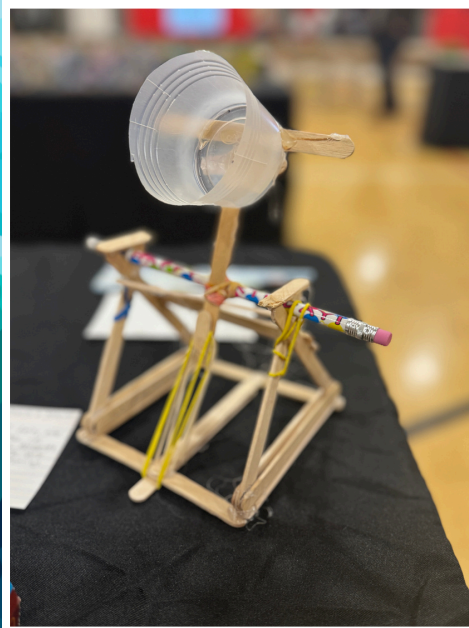
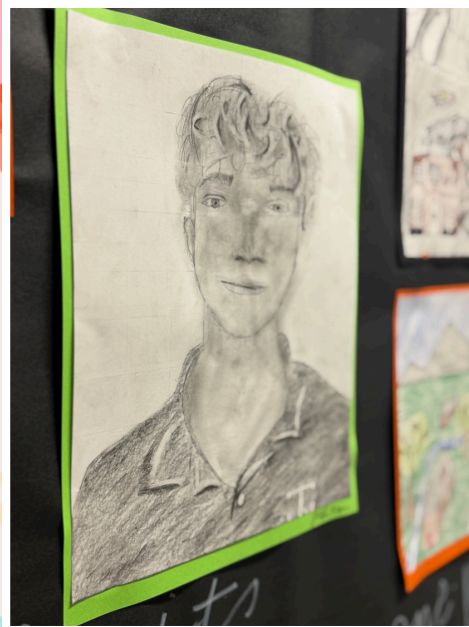
I pray that God allows me to do exactly what he tells me to do at the right time.

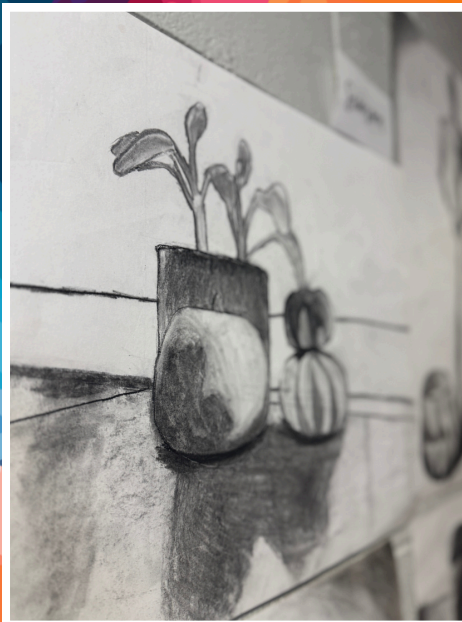
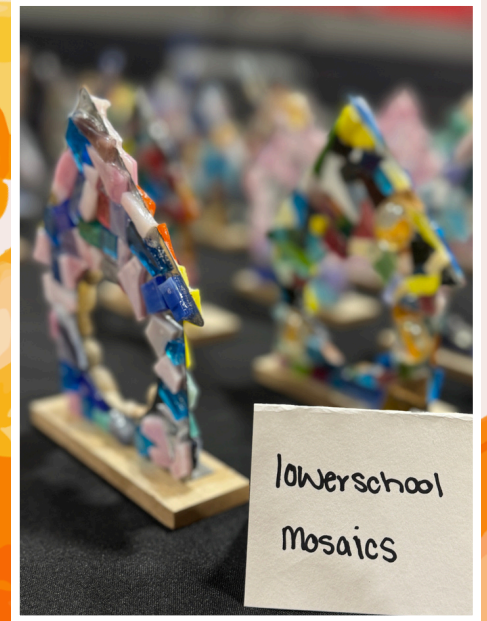
